Boys & Girls u19, u17, u15, u13 – *maximum 64 players in each category (On a first come first serve basis!!)*  
The European Junior Open is open to all players under the age of 13, 15, 17, 19 on the 12<sup>th</sup> of July 2026, as appropriate. Players may only enter one category.  
A minimum of three matches per player are guaranteed. If the draw size in some fields becomes too big, possibly not all positions will be played out!

All matches will be played as best of five games, under the rules of the WSF. PAR scoring to 11 will be used at all tournaments on the ESF Junior Circuit (to 2 clear points).

## **ENTRIES**

All players must register **online** at

All entries must be made through / endorsed by the relevant national federation. Any entry not endorsed by a player's national federation will not be accepted. All entries will be acknowledged and published on the tournament website.

## **DRAWS/SEEDINGS**

The seeding and timings for the first match will be circulated to all players or their national/regional associations by e-mail, at least 5 days before the start of the event. Times of first matches will be indicated for their players. The seeding will be carried out using the ESF Junior Rankings valid at the closing date and in accordance with the [ESF Junior Circuit Guidelines](#).

## **LATE ARRIVALS**

The tournament host assumes no responsibility for late arrivals. Players who are not on the court at the scheduled match time may forfeit the game in accordance with the rules.

## **PHYSIO**

The physio will be present during playing hours and stationed to the right of the glass court. Players who sustain an injury during a match may contact the physio.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

Any player is entitled to enter provided that he or she is under the age of 13, 15, 17, or 19 respectively, according to the category entered, on the closing date of the tournament.

Any player / manager / coach / physiotherapist or supervising parent, attending the event in an official capacity are required to have an ESID number, which can be requested via the European Squash Federation database website.

Please note: ESID registers the individual person, not the role. (Registration process for coaches or parents say role: player)

The background to this requirement is the safeguarding of all children at the tournament – everyone present in an official capacity must be registered.

All competitors at ESF approved Junior tournaments must wear approved protective eye guards, manufactured to an appropriate national safety standard, properly over the eyes at all times during competition play. It is the responsibility of the player to ensure that the quality of the product is satisfactory for the purpose. Players will not be allowed to compete without this protection. Players enter and play in the tournament at their own risk. Neither the organisers nor the ESF accept any responsibility for injury arising from participating in the event. Players must arrange their own insurance. All players must wear approved protective eye guards on court.

## WEB AND MEDIA PUBLISHING

The European Junior Open will be publishing draws, results, photos of players as well as live footage from matches, players and the venue. As this is part of the European Junior Open tournament rules, German Squash (DSQV) will deem that players and their parents have accepted these regulations by entering the tournament.

## PSA

The European Junior Open is registered with PSA as a Closed Satellite. The best 32 players (girls and boys) in the u17 and u19 categories can claim points with the PSA.
